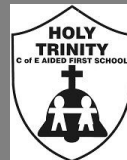

Year 3

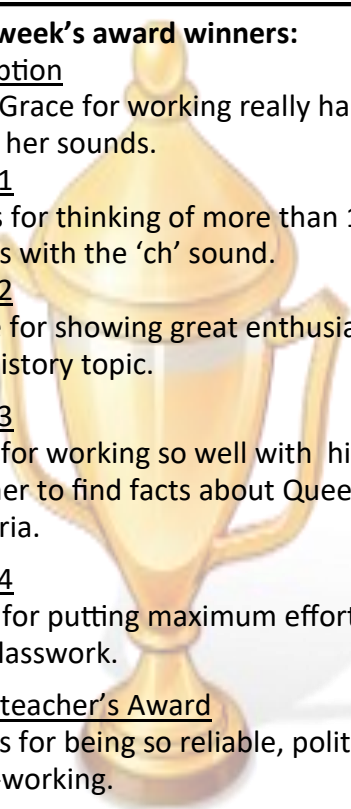
Liam for working so well with his partner to find facts about Queen Victoria.
