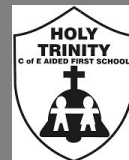

Year 3

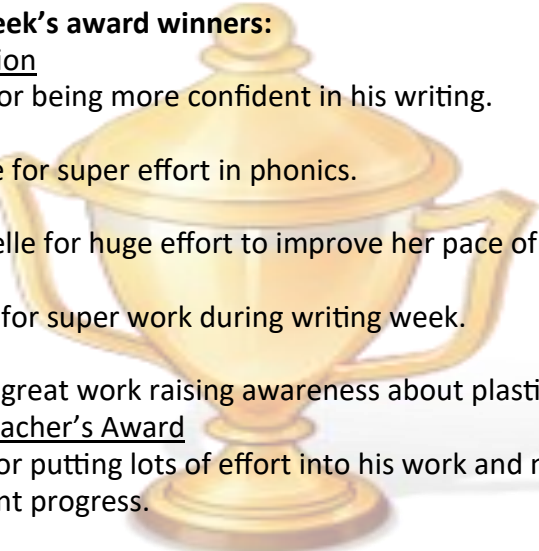
Scarlet for super work during writing week.
