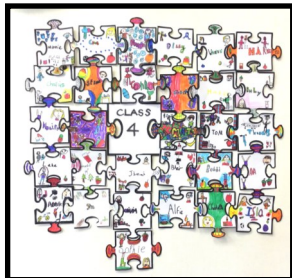


All Different . All Equal
