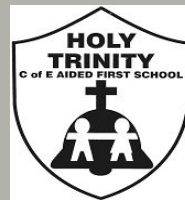

### Year 3

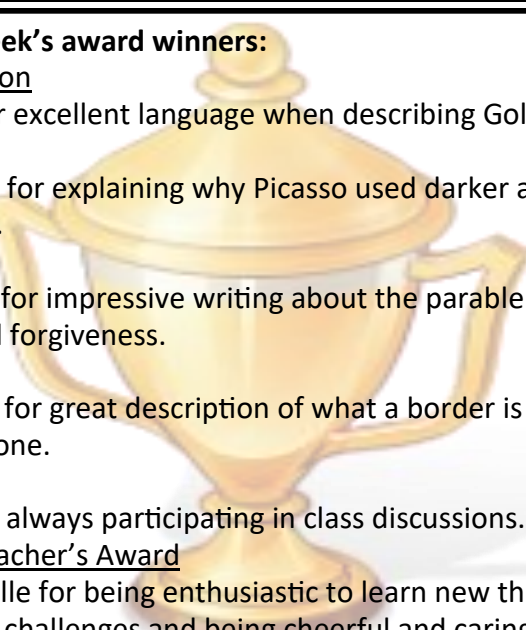
Martha for great description of what a border is and where to find one.

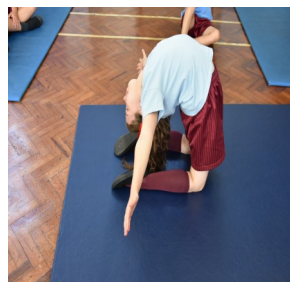
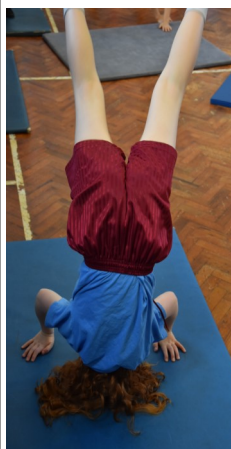
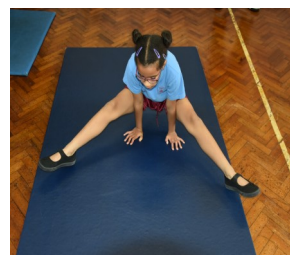
