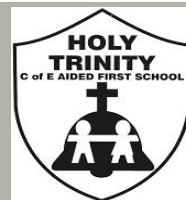

Class 1 - designed party plates.

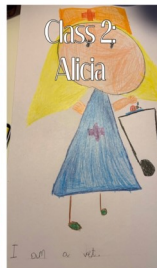
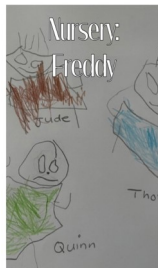
Class 2 - thought about future jobs.

Reading Support

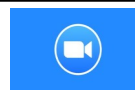
Please keep reading in as many ways as you can.
