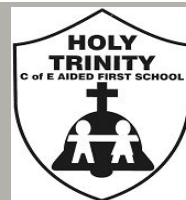

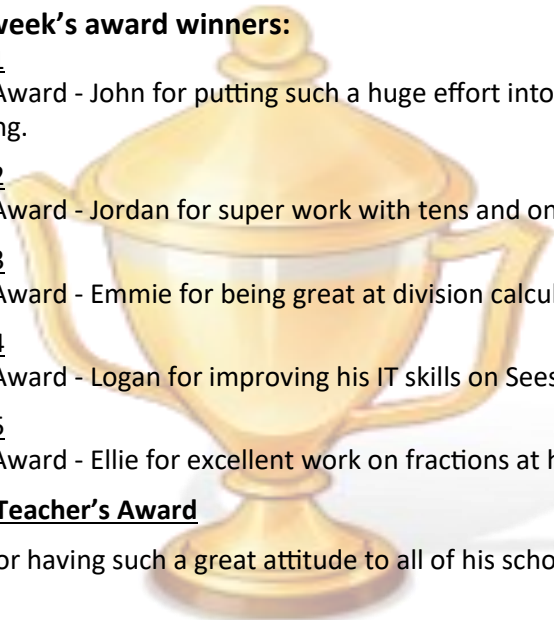
Class Award - Logan for improving his IT skills on Seesaw.
