School Update

Thank you for your support this half-term. It has been wonderful to welcome all of our children back to school and get back to something a little more like our normal routines. After the holiday we are going to make a further change to our arrangements and all classes will go back to finishing school at 3.15pm. This will mean that there may be more parents on our yard at one time and we would please ask that you continue to remain socially distanced whilst outside, to keep children next to you whilst waiting for siblings and leave the site as soon as possible.

Children should come back to school in winter uniform after the holiday, Early Years staff will send a separate message about Nursery and Reception, for the rest of school, uniform should be as follows.

Boys - light blue shirt, school tie, burgundy v-necked jumper, grey shorts or trousers, grey socks, black school shoes.

Girls - light blue shirt, school tie, grey/tartan pinafore or skirt, burgundy v-necked jumper or cardigan, grey, black or burgundy socks or tights, black school shoes.

Shorts, short sleeved tee-shirts and plimsolls are required for P.E. and should always be available in school. On swimming days, children can wear a school hoodie, burgundy jogging pants, polo shirts and trainers which are easier to manage. All items of clothing need to be marked clearly with the child's name.

If your child wears boots to school in the winter, please also bring in a pair of shoes that they can wear indoors. Your child should be able to run safely in their shoes. Thank you as always for your support.
